A new Phone System was installed in order to facilitate emergency dialing outside the property, as well as call within. Fiber optic cable was run throughout the property.

With this new technology, our infrastructure is outfitted well for providing better internet connection now and in the future.

The equipment for the new phone system was delivered in Late September 2020. Technically Amazing/Kevin Longo began running fiber optic cable to the units on 11/26/20. As of the end of December 2020, all cable had been run through conduit to the units.

The project was delayed due to the fact that building 21–24 is on a concrete slab. A new method of wiring was needed, as such the new equipment that was required was ordered. After some minor delays, the project was completed on March 19, 2021.



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## SCOPE OF PHONE AND FIBER OPTIC WIRE INSTALLATION



Fiber optic cable was run from the clubhouse through newly laid conduit to each building.



Cable was then run to each individual unit



Voice over IP phones were installed in each unit and throughout the clubhouse/admin offices

The new phone system allows for direct 911 emergency calling. The system provides an exact glaobal position and address of the emergency call to Police and Fire Department. Alerts management of an emergency as well.



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## SCOPE OF WINDOW REPLACEMENT PROJECT



#### Fall/Winter 2020-2021

Units Vanderbilt - 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 installed a total of 9 windows. Westinghouse 3,4,5,6 (master bedroom) and Westinghouse 8 (entryway window) 5 windows total among Westinghouse units. Work began November 12. All work in building 7-12 was completed by December 1, 2020.

Window Repair in Building 1-6. Scope of work: To replace the remaining rotted and broken windows in the front of Vanderbilt and Westinghouse buildings. This proposal includes replacing the visible rotted framing, jacking entryway floors, installing new siding and trim.



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#### LIGHTING UPGRADE

- In conjunction with National Grid we installed energy saving lights in the units and on the outside of the buildings.
- This project allows the Ponds to save money on our electric & gas bill by using energy more efficiently. And, through the power of action, we reduce greenhouse gases (CO2) annually by 30,555 pounds.
